§156-1 Purpose

An ordinance to prohibit the feeding of unconfined wildlife in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by Lower Alloways Creek to protect the environment, public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.

§156-2 Regulated Activities

No person shall feed, in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by Lower Alloways Creek any wildlife.

§156-3 Exemptions

Exemptions include unconfined wildlife at environmental education centers and feral cats as part of an approved Trap-Neuter-Release program.

§156-4 Enforcement

This ordinance shall be enforced by the Honor System.

§156-5 Violations and Penalties

Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed fifty dollars (\$ 50.00)
